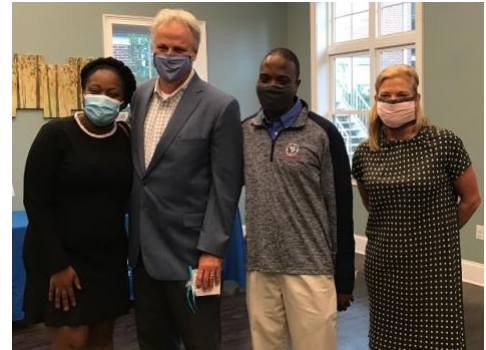




Capital Campaign Update

Campaign donors, volunteers, HNM board members, and staff gathered to celebrate the official close of **Putting Families First: The Campaign for Homeless No More** on Thursday, October 29th.

The celebration was held on the Family Shelter campus and offered attendees a glimpse of how the needs of HNM families will continue to be met as capital projects such as the dormitory renovations get underway.



Over \$5.8 million dollars was raised through public and private funds in under two years to support a new master plan that includes the construction of a new education center, renovation of the Family Shelter dorms, renovation of administrative space and shared amenities at both Family Shelter and St. Lawrence Place, and construction of 15 units of affordable housing.
